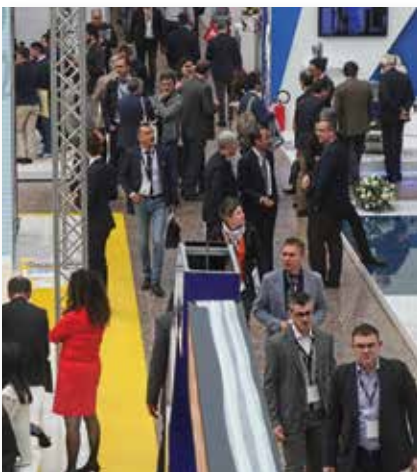

# OMC 2017 conference highlights

# Transition to a SUSTAINABLE ENERGY MIX - the contribution of the oil & gas industry

First day Session - Keywords

**INNOCENZO TITONE** - Chairman OMC 2017

"We are in a period of transition towards a Low Carbon Economy and the O&G Industry can make a positive contribution thanks to its distinctive technological capabilities, the passion for innovation and, last but not the least, its financial resources.

But no easy transition to a sustainable energy mix will be achieved without an integration of renewables with fossil sources and among the fossils natural gas will play a big role."



**IVAN SCALFAROTTO** - Undersecretary of International Trade and Investment Attraction, Ministry of Economic Development

"Italy hopes that an effective cooperation will be developed within the countries in the areas - Egypt, Cyprus, Lebanon, Israel for exploitation and distribution of gas resources of the East Med in order to assess the potential export of natural gas by the East Med pipeline and LNG to Italy and Europe."



**TAREK EL MOLLA** - Minister of Petroleum and Mineral Resource of Egypt

"Our strategy is to play the role of the regional hub, not necessarily for gas only, but also for electricity, crude and refining products. We are really qualified to play this role: having the infrastructures, the market, the law to allow this activity to happen freely and we will be glad to integrate with our neighboring countries, who have developing gas reserves to exploit."



**YIORGOS LAKKOTRYPIS** - Minister of Energy of Cyprus

"Tamar, Leviathan, Aphrodite and Zohr discoveries will ensure the long term strategic security supplies for all the Mediterranean countries and a sustainable future, therefore cooperation is "the key" for developing our energy scenario. The reserves of Aphrodite will be almost completely earmarked for export in a few months. Cyprus is looking strategically to integrate with neighboring states, with the aim of complementing each other."



**MARC BENAYOUN** - CEO Edison

"There's a growing trend towards renewables today but in the same time fossil fuels will be needed for long time and there's a potential to grow the production of fossil fuels in a cleaner way and also to develop cleaner solutions along the value chain."



**CLAUDIO DESCALZI** - CEO Eni

"Gas and hydrocarbons won the competition with renewables because of the low prices. If we avoid this fight between resources, and we mix them, we can reduce costs, increase availability and internal rate return of sources. They work together and that is our model."



**REMI ERIKSEN** - President DNV GL

"By energy convergence I also see opportunities for the "greening" of gas, for power and heating with hydrogen and biomethane. However to make these opportunities a reality it is critical for safety and performance to fully understand all the effects of new sources of gas and what that have on existing infrastructure."
